John Ulmer, MD

Dr. Ulmer was a board-certified, tenured professor at the Medical College of Wisconsin in the department of radiology, where he provided care for patients, trained healthcare providers, and conducted translational research for over 24 years. He was the chief of the division of neuroradiology, director of neuroradiology research, and served on numerous departmental and extradepartmental committees. He was dedicated to advancing clinical care for the benefit of the patients he served.

Andy Klein, MD

Dr. Klein is a board-certified assistant professor of radiology at the Medical College of Wisconsin and section chief of neuroradiology. His clinical and research interests include functional brain mapping, traumatic brain injury, cognitive neuroimaging, and 7 Tesla magnetic resonance imaging. He has received federal, industry, and institutional grant funding for his research projects and was co-principal investigator for a study funded by GE Healthcare and the NFL investigating advanced magnetic resonance imaging applications for mild traumatic brain injury.
